As a registered artist, you will get a set of sidewalk chalk and a square of sidewalk to work with. Squares will be assigned upon check-in on the morning of the event. Please see rules for specific details. Prizes will be offered for both adults and children.

Rules:

- A set of sidewalk chalk will be provided to each artist; you are not permitted to bring your own chalk or use any other materials other than the chalk provided to you by event organizers. Chalk provided is a non-oil based, washable chalk. No acrylic paints, liquid pastels, oil-based pastels, hard pastels, etc. will be allowed.
- We prefer adult drawings to be in the Madonnari street art style or something similar.
- Designs must not exceed beyond their designated square.
- All artwork must be appropriate for public viewing by all ages; No lewd, graphic violence, gore, nudity, etc.
- No political messages, words or symbols intended as advertising may appear in the image or space provided.
- Don't forget to sign your artwork!
- No stenciling. Artwork must be created freehand.
- Digital photos will be taken, the event committee reserves the right to use photographs for marketing, promotion and publicity purposes.
- Organizers have the right to disqualify and/or remove any inappropriate art or writing as they may deem necessary.
- Organizers and judges have the right to modify or add to these rules, as necessary.
- Spaces will be assigned on a first come first served basis.
- Judging based on a 1-5 scale on first impression, creativity, originality, skill, and use of color, etc.
- Decisions of the judges and organizers are final.
- Organizers are not responsible for damage or defacing of artwork.

Day of Event:

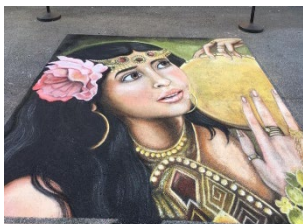
- Artists must check in at between 12:30 and 1:00 pm to pick up their supplies.
- Pre-registered artists or artist group not checked in by 12:30 pm risk losing their sidewalk square and chance to participate.
- Artwork should be completed by 4:00 pm.
- Artists should check out before/by 4:00 pm and return any unused supplies.
- Judging will take place as artists complete their designs or at 4:00 pm whichever comes first.
- A digital photo will be taken to preserve the artwork. Winners will be announced at approximately 5:00 pm.

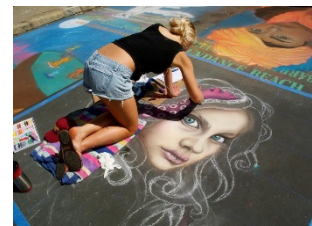
